NLOC FACILITIES

Woodward Park

Knights Hill Park

Knights Hill Park, adjacent to Woodward Park, is 100 acres of natural habitat set aside for the protection of wildlife and dedicated to the aesthetic appreciation, conservation and scientific study of nature. A quiet, peaceful retreat for people, its nature and hiking trails, talks, and other outdoor programs are open to all.

Outing Club Indoor Center ("OCIC")

The "OCIC" is the gym, stage, Activity Room areas and playing fields at the former KRMS-New London. We lease the space and offer year round indoor and outdoor programs and activities.

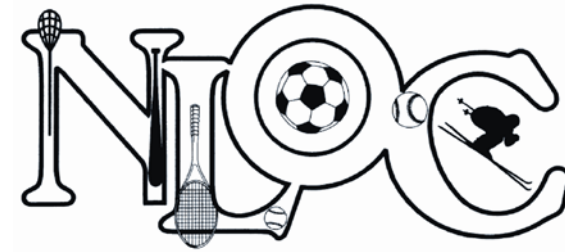
